The teaching proposal focused on the development of a project for Via Catullo, a small street in the northwest suburbs of Milan that, despite the small dimensions that characterize it, suffers from a mix of problems: social marginalization, precarious housing situations, urban decay, complex forms of coexistence among different ethnic groups.

The teaching activity involves students in the elaboration of policy and design strategies, which could serve as hypothesis for concrete intervention in the area.
