



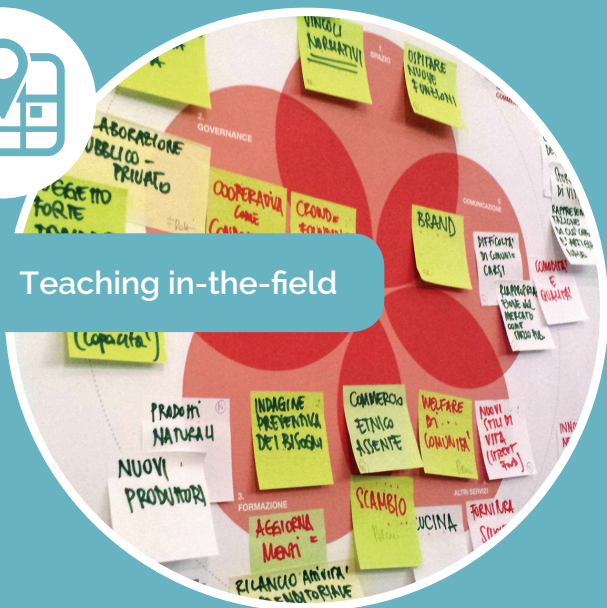

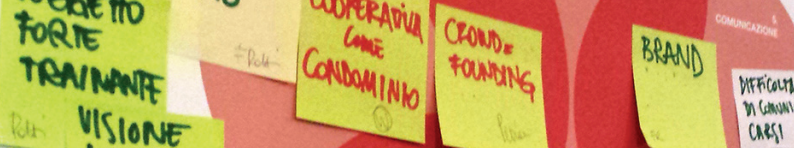

The teaching proposal investigates two different neighborhoods in Milan: the historic neighborhood of Lorenteggio, a public housing neighborhood, and the Santa Giulia neighborhood, a new “uncompleted” urban transformation. Both contexts express, among many issues, a need for revitalization that entails the rethinking of the presence and the role of small commercial spaces and activities. Students started a dialogue with inhabitants and local stakeholders to develop hypotheses of intervention and transformation able to give new relevance to the local commercial systems and to all local activities, regenerating social practices and spaces.
