



The Course promotes a new culture of international cooperation among students, scholars and practitioners active in the fields of Architecture, Urban Planning and Urban Design through a multi-disciplinary training concerning the streams of study, field researches and experimental projects on the Global South currently produced at the international level. By fostering an approach that combines theory, research and action, the Course provides the last generations of expert in urban studies with the capability of deep understanding and integrated intervention approach to development in contexts marked by high socio-economic and territorial vulnerability. The education and training proposal of the Course covers a wide range of topics (including socio-spatial inequality, spatial conflicts, informality, management of the territorial risks and WEF nexus, sustainable heritage, new technologies for development and social innovation, capacity building, empowerment and local governance) and is enhanced by seminars of international experts and geographical and thematic focusses, that in the present edition will regard Africa.

ELIGIBILITY

The Course is reserved to candidates with a university Diploma or any equivalent qualifications in Architecture, Engineering, Urban Planning, Design, Sociology, Economics and other scientific subjects. Simultaneous enrollments in a Post-graduate Course, Master of Science or PhD are also considered compatible with the Course attendance. A good knowledge of English is also required as the course is taught in English. Foreign candidates in possession of an equivalent qualifications from their university systems will be considered eligible.
